Mold Maker / Tool Leader Job Opening

We are seeking a seasoned Mold Maker / Tool Leader with all around experience in surface grinding, milling, die sink and/or CNC EDM and mold assembly to assist with the planning, monitoring and construction of new plastic injection molds in our Tooling Division.

Primary Duties:

- a) Reviewing new tooling jobs and planning the sequence of operations and team members needed to complete the work within quoted budget and established delivery timeframes.
- (b) Monitoring the progress of assigned jobs on a regular basis to assess the completion status of tooling jobs, assess actions needed to keep jobs on-schedule, and report job progress at weekly tooling schedule meetings.
- (c) Setting up and operating tool room machinery (surface grinders, mills, EDM machinery, etc.) to assist with the construction of high precision mold components and cavity/core details.
- (d) Inspecting machined parts to verify dimensions meet print requirements and ensure quality standards are met.
- (e) Coordinating the fitting and assembling of components and/or complete molds to check function and prepare mold for pre-production sampling and/or customer delivery per established customer delivery dates.
- (f) Assisting with the conditioning & revision work needed to validate / receive approval on new production molds.
- (g) Communicating regularly with Tooling, QA and Molding personnel on work progress and production activities.

- (a) At least 6 8 years of mold building experience in a precision Tooling or Machine shop environment;
- (b) Familiarity with machining operations/techniques required to build precision mold components (surface grinding,
- (c) Previous completion of a formal Apprenticeship program is preferred, but not essential;
- (d) Detailed knowledge of shop mathematics, mold construction and assembly / disassembly procedures, and shop equipment used in a mold building facility;
- (e) Ability to read 2D/3D mechanical blue print drawings and have good mechanical ability;
- (f) Basic computer skills are preferred
- (g) A take charge attitude with sound decision making abilities and an independent work ethic.
- (h) The ability to set priorities while also adapting to unanticipated changes to production requirements / schedules.
